



## Assistant/ Associate Professor Tenure Track

**Position:** The Department of Nutrition at the C.W. Post Campus of Long Island University seeks applications for a tenure track faculty position at the assistant or associate rank starting Fall 2010. We seek candidates with experience in foods or nutrition, who would support our accredited Didactic Program in Dietetics (DPD), our Dietetic Internship (DI) program, and our graduate program. The position involves undergraduate and graduate teaching in areas related to foods and nutrition. Candidates within a broad range of nutrition and food specialties are encouraged to apply. Additional responsibilities include conducting research, directing undergraduate and graduate theses, curriculum development, and academic and professional service.

**Minimum Qualifications:** An earned doctorate in food, nutrition or closely-related field, with Registered Dietitian (RD) credential preferred. Candidates must demonstrate outstanding oral and written communication skills, excellent interpersonal skills and have evidence of scholarly competence. Positive teaching experiences and a strong commitment to teach and mentor undergraduate and graduate students are required.
