The position will work closely with the Muskie School public health staff and faculty, the University of Maine Department of Food Science and Human Nutrition faculty, and program managers in the Maine Department of Health and Human Services. Grant funded projects will focus on evaluating nutrition and physical activity interventions and building capacity of allied research staff in program evaluation methodology. Successful candidate may also be involved in developing and delivering elective courses. Additional duties at the University will focus on collaborative initiatives with other faculty and staff, and development of a public health nutrition/physical activity research portfolio.
