**Faculty Position in Behavior and Nutrition

Assistant, Associate or Full Professor  
Tenure-track research and teaching appointment**

The Friedman School of Nutrition Science and Policy, a graduate school at Tufts University, seeks a faculty member specializing in the area of behavioral science as part of its ongoing effort to build its expertise in the relationships between behavior, diet, nutrition, and physical activity. Candidates are desired who have expertise in least one of the following areas:

- Community behavior and its determinants.
- Institutional behavior and behavior change.
- Interventions to improve health behaviors (dietary intake and physical activity) within populations and communities.
- Behavioral factors promoting dietary patterns and dietary change in individuals or families.
- Models of human behavior and behavior change.
- Experience working with populations both within and outside of the United States would be advantageous.

This is a full-time, 12-month position. This is a tenure-track position; rank (Assistant, Associate or Professor), salary and benefits are competitive and will be commensurate with the successful candidate's experience. The starting date is negotiable.

Candidates should have earned a doctoral degree and have postdoctoral training relevant to behavioral science. A record of independent research and publications, ideally with external financial support, is expected. Candidate's areas of research should complement the Friedman School's existing strengths in nutrition, physical activity, and policy. Applicants are expected to develop a vigorous research program, to teach 2-3 graduate level courses per year, to supervise doctoral dissertations and to advise graduate students at the masters and doctoral levels.
