

Assistant/Associate Professor Position in Department of Exercise and Nutrition Sciences

Candidates should have an earned Ph.D. or equivalent in a discipline relevant to exercise and/or nutrition sciences. Postdoctoral research experience is required. A record of achievement in research with publications in high quality journals is expected.

Candidates for Associate Professor are expected to also have an established and current record of extramurally funded research. The candidates' research should complement existing departmental research strengths in biomechanics, exercise physiology, or nutrition as they relate to public health. The candidates' academic goals should embrace the school's mission to improve the health of populations, communities, and individuals through disciplinary and interdisciplinary education, research, and service.
