EXPAND YOUR KNOWLEDGE

ASN members receive free online access to *The American Journal of Clinical Nutrition* (AJCN), *The Journal of Nutrition* (JN), and *Advances in Nutrition*. AJCN, first published in 1952, is the highest ranked peer-reviewed journal in nutrition and dietetics. JN, in print since 1928, carries original, peer-reviewed research in key areas of nutrition. Both journals are widely read and carry significant impact factors. ASN members are also eligible for discounted print subscriptions, waived submission fees and other journal services.

In addition, members are eligible to receive *Nutrition Today*, an official ASN partner publication, at a 58% discount from the regular subscription rate. Members also receive *Nutrition Notes*, a quarterly newsletter which provides news of member activities, meetings, student programs and the ASN Foundation. The ASN website offers a continually updated feed of nutrition news, an archive of member e-newsletters, and educational tools such as videos of past EB lectures, webinars and the graduate program directory.

GET AHEAD IN YOUR CAREER

Our association offers many smaller communities for networking and thematic programming. All members are eligible to join unlimited Research Interest Sections (RIS). The RIS are communities designed to provide a mechanism for topic-specific discussion. Research Interest Sections include Community and Public Health Nutrition, Diet and Cancer, Energy and Macronutrient Metabolism, Experimental Animal Nutrition, Nutritional Immunology and more (see list on reverse).

Along with the RIS, ASN's three Councils represent the broad spectrum of nutrition research among its members. Members are encouraged to join the following Scientific Councils: International Nutrition, Medical Nutrition, and Nutritional Sciences. You may join all three Councils at no additional cost, but declaring a primary interest in one Council will enable you to vote for officers.

In recognition of our members' professional accomplishments, ASN annually administers over twenty awards. ASN members are also eligible to earn Continuing Medical Education (CME) and other credits for professional development, and benefit from numerous inter-industry partnerships.

SUPPORT NUTRITION SCIENCE

We advocate for our members by working with Congress, federal agencies and international stakeholders on issues that impact nutrition research and practice. Increasing funding for nutrition research and nutrition monitoring are top public policy priorities. Public affairs programming includes advocacy and policy-related symposia, Capitol Hill visits and Congressional briefings. Members receive public policy newsletters, action alerts and tools for getting involved.

ASN members receive a substantially discounted registration to ASN Scientific Sessions and Annual Meeting at Experimental Biology (EB). EB is an interdisciplinary, scientific meeting that brings together 15,000 scientists from throughout the world. EB 2013, to be held April 20-24 in Boston, MA, will offer presidential sessions, symposia, oral and poster sessions, career services, social networking opportunities and much more. Additionally, ASN members receive discounted registration to our annual clinical conference, *Advances and Controversies in Clinical Nutrition*, as well as co-sponsored meetings throughout the year.
