

Class of 2015 ASN Fellows Nomination Criteria

To be inducted as a Fellow of the American Society for Nutrition is the highest honor that ASN bestows. Scientists who have had distinguished careers in nutrition and are at least sixty-five years of age are eligible for nomination. Membership in the Society is not a requirement for eligibility. Nominations may be made by any member of the Society.

Nominators are required to submit a supporting statement (1-4 pages) and the candidate's curriculum vitae (CV).

Directly address the following qualifications in your supporting statement (exceptional contribution in all of these areas is not required for qualification):

- Contributions as a researcher, clinician, educator or other professional in the field of nutrition
- Demonstration of dedication to excellence in nutrition research or practice
- Contributions to the body of science-based nutrition information (examples include: research publications, patents, reviews, and educational materials)
- Commitment to the translation and dissemination of science-based nutrition information
- Public service or benefit of the nominee's work to society as a whole
- Leadership (examples include: participation in committees, mentorship programs, advisory panels, conferences)
- Reputation and credibility within the broader scientific community
- Honors, awards and other evidence of recognitions received (including international recognition)
