We are seeking highly motivated candidates with a strong interest in diet, epigenetics, and cancer prevention. Salary will be based on University guidelines for postdoctoral scholars.

**Qualifications:** Ph.D. in biochemistry, nutrition, molecular toxicology or related fields. Preference given to candidates who obtained their Ph.D. degree within the past two years, and who have published in areas related to epigenetic mechanisms and cancer.
