RESPONSIBILITIES: The successful candidate will teach courses in community nutrition, personal nutrition, and other courses as necessary at undergraduate and graduate levels. S/he will also be expected to develop a strong, funded research program. Additional responsibilities to include: advising and mentoring undergraduate and graduate students; serving on graduate student, departmental, and/or college committees; and performing community outreach activities. The community nutrition graduate program complies with guidelines established by the Association of Graduate Programs in Public Health Nutrition. Collaborative departmental research focus areas include, but not limited to, obesity, diabetes and functional foods.

QUALIFICATIONS: Earned doctorate in human nutrition public health or related field at the time of appointment with competency in community nutrition and preferably an RD. The successful candidate will have an accomplished record of scholarly activity, the ability to collaborate with faculty in related disciplines, and the ability to interface with existing commodity based research and education programs. Individuals with interests in the areas of obesity, diabetes, functional foods, or other public health issues are particularly encouraged to apply. The successful candidate must have the ability to work effectively with students, colleagues, and public health agency personnel, and the broader community, as well as have potential for excellence in teaching.
